4. Competition Dates:

The 17th (Friday) till the 19th (Sunday) of April, 2015

5. Qualifications:

- * Must be a holder of nationality of the Participating country
- * Must be recommended by the National Association Member of WTF (entry must be supported with the list of participants signed by MNA President or General Secretary)
- * For Senior and Junior age categories athletes are required to have Dan/Poom Certificate.

For Cadets age category the technical Qualification level must be at least - 4 Gup.

* WTF Global License is mandatory for all age categories.

6. Age:

Senior - born in 1998 years and older

Junior – born in 1998-2000 Cadet - born in 2001-2003

8. Time mode:

Seniors & Juniors - 3 rounds x 2 minutes (1 min. break) Cadets - 3 rounds x 1,30 minutes (1 min. break)

Male and Female Divisions' contestants quantity respectively is not limited unless the general number of participants is reached (see Point 13)

11. Protective Equipment & Uniform:

The participants shall wear the WTF recognised Taekwondo Uniform. Daedo PSS will be used at this Tournament. Daedo Electronic Body Protectors and Head gears will be provided by the OC. Groin/forearm/shin guards and gloves are compulsory and must be brought by the contestants. Mouth piece is compulsory! All athletes must bring their own Daedo sensor socks.

12. Medical Control:

Use of drugs or doping by any chemical substances prescribed in the WTF Regulations for Doping Control is strongly prohibited. The medical doping tests will be carried out by the Doping Control Company at random sampling.

13. Applications:

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS is the 31st of March 2015.

Entries after the deadline will not be accepted by any reasons. Entries for Seniors, Juniors and Cadets categories will stop at 600

If you do not upload the pictures on-line the Organising Committee will charge you 20€ to place your picture at the accreditation centre.

The Entry Fee for each participant is 75€ per athlete. It must be paid ONLY in cash at the accreditation desk upon arrival.

IMPORTANT: If the athlete registered on-line http://www.tpss.nl does not take part in the competition for some reason, but he/she has not been removed from the list of participants before the end of on-line registration which is (March 31st, 2015), his team official must fully (100%) pay his Entry fee for participation. Entry fee is not

refundable back to the participant!

It is the responsibility of each MNA to make sure that the forms attached to the Outline are properly filled in. The additional forms are to be signed correctly by participants and the official representatives of the National Associations. Each MNA must ensure that they have a sufficient insurance coverage for each contestant and official member. Accreditation center will be open at the SPORT HALL "Manejul de Atletism" Andrei Doga str, 26 (Chisinau) 10.00 – 18.00, April 16, 2015. Official representatives (1 or 2 persons per Team only) must present for checking each participant's and official's passports (or the Certificate of Birth for minors) and pay in the Entry Fees for the whole team. Doctors can get their accreditation only if they present their medical Certificate. Accreditations may only be given out if the Team paid the Entry Fee in full amount. Teams arriving after the Accreditation Centre Closing Time (18.00 p.m.) may only be accredited if they inform OC in advance. The attendance of the "Moldova Open" 2015 Tournament will only be possible by an accreditation or a ticket.

The weigh-in of the contestants takes place on the previous day of the weight division that they compete. During the weigh-in, contestants can wear underwear. However the contestant may weigh-in nude if he/she wishes to do so. If the athlete has to change his/her weight category after the weigh-in −this will cost 30€ per person.

1st place, 2nd place and two 3rd places winners will be awarded with Medals, Diplomas.
